


Madison Metro Makes Changes to Route 73 Affecting Access to OSTP

Madison Metro has announced changes to Route 73, which provides bus access to and through Old Sauk Trails Park.

The new route no longer provides riders access to businesses along Excelsior Drive, and instead, is re-routed to travel along Deming Way until it reaches Greenway Blvd.

The route changes will be implemented in 2023.

Introducing elephas

Andler Dental Highlights CEREC Dentistry

At Andler Dental, we have used CEREC technology for over 15 years. It allows us to create an all ceramic strong tooth colored crown in one visit. (No second appointment needed and no goopy impression material!)

Step by step process:

- We will get you comfortable with the right mix of dental anesthetic, using topical gel first. Then we sit you up and wait 5 minutes to make sure you are completely numb before we begin.
- We clean and shape the tooth as needed and then we scan in the tooth. The CEREC scanner is an intraoral handheld camera that creates a vivid and very detailed 3D image of the mouth. Scans are taken of your upper and lower arches and put together digitally. All of this information is gathered within seconds and is needed for the crown designing process.
- The doctor then designs the ideal shape and size for the new crown. At this point, you get a 20 minute break.
- We try on the crown to ensure a great fit and make any adjustments as needed. There is then another short break to glaze and fire the crown. This ensures a strong, smooth, beautiful crown.
- We then complete the procedure by cementing in the final crown and recheck the biting pressure.

All in all, it ends up being about a 2 hour appointment from start to finish, with several breaks in the middle. With the help of CEREC, this in-office system allows more comfortable and efficient dentistry to be achieved each and every time.

Iconica Spotlights Favorite Community Organizations

Iconica supports many community organizations throughout the year, often using our food truck, ACE. We'd like to shine a light on a few of our favorites.

<u>Middleton Outreach Ministry (MOM)</u>: MOM brings our community together to create food and housing security through action and advocacy for neighbors in West Madison, Middleton and Cross Plains. MOM hosts one of the largest food pantries in Dane County. Nearly half of those served through MOM are children. Last year, ACE delivered food as part of our holiday giving campaign. ACE also provided water and treats at their school supply/backpack distribution.

Girls on the Run of South Central Wisconsin: Girls on the Run has fun, evidence-based programs that inspire all girls to build their confidence, kindness and decision-making skills. Dynamic lessons instill valuable life skills including the important connection between physical and emotional health. Iconica supports them by donating storage space and meeting space for their coach training and supply assembly. Iconica supports their twice yearly 5k runs with use of a truck. In June of this year, ACE supported the run by giving out water to participants and their families.





<u>The RCC – Sexual Violence Resource Center:</u> Serving Dane County since 1973, the RCC (formerly the Rape Crisis Center) is a non-profit organization that provides services to survivors (and their support people) of all forms of sexual violence, including recent sexual assault, past sexual assault, incest (past or present), sexual harassment, and sexual exploitation. ACE has supported two RCC events with transportation and delivery of food.

<u>Madison Reading Project</u>: Madison Reading Project connects families, educators and our community with free books and literacy resources that ignite a love for reading and affirm and reflect the diversity of young readers. Last year, ACE delivered books and treats to MRPs new book center on Greenway Cross in Madison. This year, we are supporting their Community Book Drive starting November 10. Our construction team has supported installation of some of their Little Free Libraries.

<u>Make-A-Wish Wisconsin:</u> Make-A-Wish shines a light of hope for children fighting critical illnesses when they need it most. With the support of many individual donors, corporate sponsors, and volunteers, life-changing wishes are granted for children with critical illnesses during their darkest days. ACE supported Make-A-Wish by attending the 2022 Walk for Wishes event and distributing treats for all participants.

Savant Ranked #33 Top RIA Firms of 2022

Barron's ranked Savant No. 33 in its list of the Top RIA Firms of 2022, up three spots from Savant's No. 36 ranking in 2021. The financial news outlet has consistently recognized Savant in its list of top RIA firms. This annual ranking, published in September, weighed numerous factors including technology spending, staff diversity, and succession planning. Advisors who wish to be ranked, complete a survey about their practice, which Barron's verifies with regulatory databases. Barron's then applies a rankings formula to the data to generate the ranking. The formula features three major categories of calculations, including assets, revenue and quality of practice.

Savant also ranked No. 13 in *Financial Planning's RIA Leaders 2022*, which ranks the top 20 RIAs providing fee-only financial planning services. Financial Planning compiled its rankings from SEC Form ADV filings in July 2022. Financial Planning's data partner, RIA in a Box, ranked RIAs based on these six criteria:

- At least 50% of the firm's clients must be individuals or high net worth individuals
- Firms must not list commissions as a compensation arrangement
- Firms must have more than zero financial planning clients
- Firms must not list commission-taking businesses in "other business activities"
- Firms cannot be affiliated under common ownership with commissiontaking businesses
